Remarkable Achievements in Power Generation

One of the most remarkable milestones in the history of WBPDCL was the record-breaking achievement where three of its thermal plants secured spots in the top five of the Plant Load Factor (PLF) rankings in India.

In FY 22-23, out of 205 thermal power stations nationwide, Bakreswar Thermal Power Station (BKTPS) topped the list with a stellar PLF of 92.38%. Santaldih TPS and Sagardighi TPP also made it to the prestigious top five, securing the second and fifth positions with PLFs of 91.34% and 89.39%, respectively. This accomplishment not only underscores the operational excellence at WBPDCL but also highlights its unwavering commitment to providing reliable power supply.

At present, WBPDCL generated 27.61BU, with Sagardighi top PLF Ranking 93.69%. The other three power plants at Santaldih, Bakreswar and Bandel are performing within top 10 merit list.



In addition to this, WBPDCL achieved a remarkable gross generation of 31.85 billion units (BU) with an overall PLF of 85.26% for the year 22-23. This represents a growth of 33% over the last fiscal, marking a new chapter of success for the organization. The plant's performance outshone that of major private sector players, including Tata Power, Adani Power, and Reliance Power, propelling WBPDCL to the forefront of the national power generation landscape. The company's profitability has surged threefold, further validating the organization's strong operational and financial health.

The impressive performance of the plants can also be attributed to enhanced coal production from WBPDCL's own mines. The organization achieved a production of 18.65 million metric tonnes (MMT) of coal, a 60% increase from the previous year, which significantly contributed to the higher generation outputs.

By improving PM management and upgrading the existing ESP, WBPDCL ensures and meets compliance with tighter norms.WBPDCL took actions for NOX mitigation by adopting combustion modification technology and low NOXburner.For the 1st time, EHG was commissioned at one unit of Kolaghat to help grid frequency.

A significant development at WBPDCL is its achievement of self-sufficiency in coal supply for its thermal plants from captive sources. In FY24, the corporation produced 18.41 million tonnes of coal,

and in the current fiscal, it aims to increase that number to 20 million tonnes. This not only boosts the company's operational capacity but also aligns with the nation's focus on ensuring energy security while minimizing dependency on external coal suppliers.Furthermore, WBPDCL continues to uphold a commitment to responsible environmental practices. Its growth is aligned with its corporate social responsibility initiatives, aiming to promote community development and socio-economic upliftment in local areas where its plants are situated. WBPDCL's CSR initiatives honor the Triple Bottom Line approach, focusing on people, planet, and profits.
